Recommended length: 100 words
CAS Tip: Avoid intro, background info and details in the lede. After answering the who, what, where, when, why, and how, let the reader know why this story is important for them.

The featured picture, which will appear on the homepage of the Forum with your article is of specific importance and should as much as possible be in line with or carry the main message of the article.

The pictures, graphs and other images used should contribute to the storytelling. Long shots of public events (conferences, roundtables, seminars etc.), pictures of speakers behind tables and
