
EUROPEAN CITIZENS' INITIATIVE FORUM

The European Citizens' Initiative (ECI) is a unique tool that allows EU citizens to directly influence policy-making by proposing legislation to the European Commission. To launch an ECI, a group of at least seven organisers from at least seven different EU Member States is required. Once registered, an initiative must gather at least one million signatures from EU citizens within one year. Additionally, minimum thresholds must be met in at least seven Member States to ensure broad support across the EU. This infographic provides an overview of ECI data, including the number of successful initiatives, signature collection trends, and organiser demographics.





## Successful ECIs that reached the signature threshold in each Member State (2012-2025)














### COMPARISON OF FUNDING REPORTED BY SUCCESSFUL AND OTHER ECIS


Funding reported by 11 successful ECIs (2012-2025)





Age Distribution of ECI Organisers (2012-2025)








#### Geographical Distribution of ECI Organisers (2012-2025)

Distribution of ECI Organisers by Nationality







